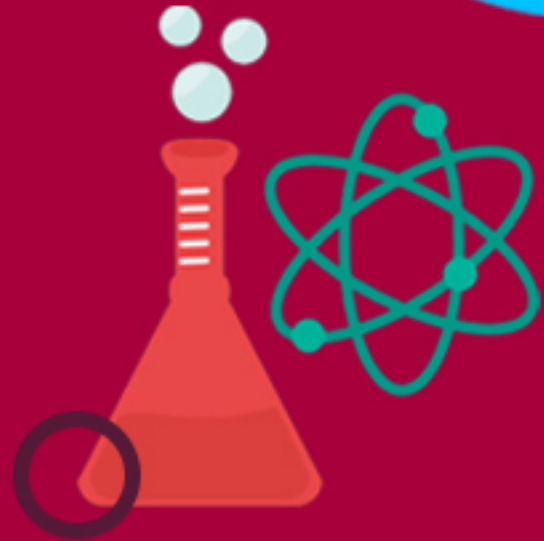

F.A.Q.

- Our staff are CPR & First Aid certified. Children ages 6 weeks-10 years old are invited to attend our Summer Program.
- Children over the age of 3 must be toilet trained in order to participate in the school-aged program.
- Children 3 years of age and younger are required to rest/nap daily.
- Diapers & wipes must be provided by parents.
- BHA Summer Program tuition includes a tshirt, special snacks, and daily activities.
- Hot lunch will be available for an additional cost.
- Students may also bring their own bagged lunch.
- Field trip fees and special outside guests fees are not included in the summer tuition and do cost additional \$.
- Only children ages 6 and up will participate in off-site field trips due to transportation requirements.
- Parents must provide students with water clothes/swimsuits towel, sunscreen, and water shoes daily-NO FLIP FLOPS!
- Elementary students will participate in Salaah (afternoon prayer)
- Drop ins will NOT be permitted as we have to plan appropriately and in advance for staffing.
- Sign ups are for each session-you can't select certain days.
- The last day to sign up for a session will be 3 weeks prior to the session start date.

CLASSES

Islamic Studies: The focus of this class is to instill in children the love of God and His messengers and a desire to live uprightly according to the noble characteristics found in the Qur'an and Sunnah.

Qur'anic Studies: Focuses on a unique, holistic approach to Qur'an memorization, wherein students memorize Qur'an at their own pace while learning how to read it with proper recitation(tajweed). Students will also study Arabic to understand the meaning in English and apply it to their life in a positive way.

Arabic Language 1: Introductory level and focuses on visual and auditory recognition of the Arabic alphabet. Simple vocabulary such as names of animals, colors, objects, and numbers will be introduced.

Arabic Language 2: Students will learn phonetic reading, writing, and audio discrimination of long and short vowels. Thematic vocabulary groups will be introduced and students will begin to build phrases and sentences in Arabic.
